## Why Report Bugs?

- To fix the bug!!!

How?

- To communicate the bug to someone (a programmer) who can fix it.

So?

- A programmer can reproduce the bug  
AND FIX IT



## Guidelines

- Show Me
- Show me how to show myself
- Always report what actually happens – not just what you think the problem is.
- Write Clearly:
  - Specific
  - Verbose (More is More!)
  - Read what you wrote

- Reporter
- Description
  - Browser
  - System State
  - Steps to Reproduce
  - Expected Result
  - Actual Result
- Priority
- Components
- Keywords
- Type
- Version
